


Knowledge to lead



Step by Step

- 1. Choose a group of participants with good communication and training skills.
- 2. Make clear that they will have to train another group of people on the same subject.
- 3. Provide them with support and coach to communicate what they learned to
- 4. Keep the main message as simple as possible to avoid its dilution or corruption during the "cascade training" process.
- 5. Make sure that the training levels won't be too much. Ideally, there should be only two, corresponding to the group receiving the initial training and a second group trained by this one. ng, networks, peer-to-peer re



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
